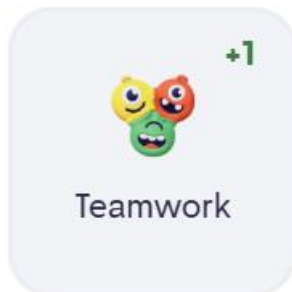
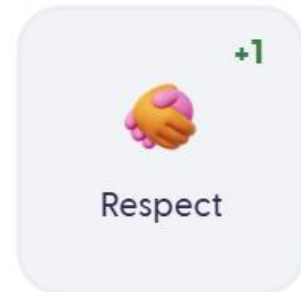
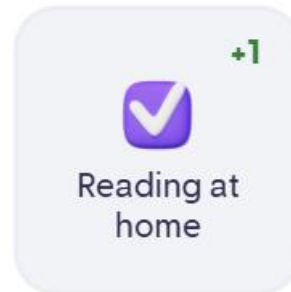
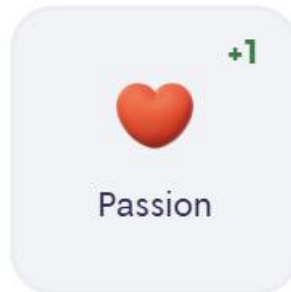
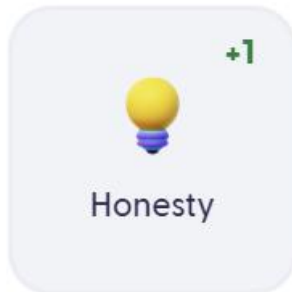
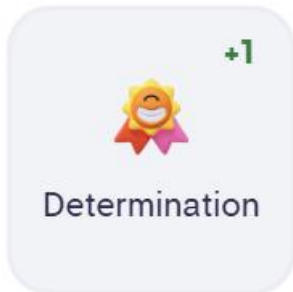
# Class Routines
