**Opening Times:** 8.00 am until 8.55 am Monday to Friday Term Time only.

**Early Start £1.00 plus breakfast club fee:** 7.30 am until 8.55 am Monday to Friday Term Time only. Places need to be booked under the heading Bookings on your child's ParentPay account.

**Cost:**

- £1.00 per child per day
- 50p for pupils entitled to Free School Meals or Pupil Premium

To be paid daily or in advance under the heading Bookings on your child's ParentPay account. We do not take cash payments for this service.

Please note that Breakfast **will not** be served after 8.40am

Children do not have to attend every day but need to book a place.

We will gladly take any letters/ personal items to the office for your child but **will not** be held liable for any loss/damage that incurs at the club.

Activities will be available to children after they have eaten their breakfast.

Children are expected to follow the clubs behaviour policy. Those who are persistent offenders may be excluded from Breakfast Club indefinitely.

The behaviour policy, equal opportunities and safeguarding children policy can be viewed at your request.


